Conference Registration Rates

- **Standard Rate**, through Oct. 1st: \$100; after Oct. 1st: \$125 (**\$6.49 service fee if paid by credit card**)

Air Travel and Ground Transportation

Air Travel:

You may fly into either Terminal 1 (Lindberg) or Terminal 2 (Humphrey) at the Minneapolis/St. Paul International Airport (MSP).

Transport from the Minneapolis/St. Paul International Airport (MSP) to the Humphrey School of Public Affairs (conference site) or hotels: Three options are available.

- **Taxi:** \$35-\$45 plus tip, one way
- **SuperShuttle:** \$16-\$18 with multiple stops, one way. Reservations highly recommended.

Once at the LRT Blue Line Station at the airport, follow these instructions: (get on the Blue Line heading north (toward Minneapolis); transfer at the Downtown East Station to the Green Line heading east (toward downtown St. Paul). Exit at the West Bank

Station for the Humphrey School (conference site); at the East Bank Station for The Commons Hotel; at the Stadium Village Station for Days Hotel on University.)
